

SFUO Meeting Notes

Proposed changes to clubs manual/operating:

- Every club must have at least 20 members (even if established and just renewing status)
- 75% of members must be undergraduate students, and all executive members must be U of O students
- 15 rooms are available to each club during the summer if need justified (I have already told them we will remain active over the summer, if we want to book a room we have to do so 5 business days in advance)
- Still need to reapply (renew?) in the fall

Club Subsidies

- Have to sign contract when you receive the subsidy outlining what the money will be spent on (justification), and receipts need to be provided afterwards; otherwise subsidies will not be provided in the future
- Yearly audit no longer exists
- Subsidy process includes presentation to clubs committee/commission to ensure transparency and consistency
- Subsidy requests are on a per-event basis, 2 weeks notice required
- What subsidies can be used for “will be better defined and communicated”

- During the elections, a \$50,000 levy for clubs went through, so this money will be available for clubs (and the SFUO, I suppose) to use
- The SFUO is considering buying A/V equipment (portable projectors and screens, DVD/VCR, speakers, etc) that clubs can use for free. There would be a security deposit involved (~\$50), and the rental program would be controlled by the SFUO.

- They are hoping to get more employees and staff to help club (1-2 more in clubs office, maybe a full-time employee during summer)

- They’re considering adding a list of clubs and their descriptions in SFUO mail-out for new students

- Renovations to clubs office are planned, providing security for equipment and a locked cabinet where clubs can store material for a short time (approx. 1 day – 1 week)

- Hopefully, increases to max allowed subsidy (from \$500-\$750).

- The proposal will be prepared by the SFUO during the summer, we should get more concrete information afterwards
